## QUICK ATTENDEE GUIDE TO THE ANNUAL MEETING

## **REGISTRATION FEES**

**Standard Registration** fee includes admission to approximately 450 scientific sessions with the opportunity to earn CME credit, admission into the Exhibit Hall and a registration badge with access to the shuttle bus service from official meeting hotels to the San Diego Convention Center.

**Gold Registration** includes the **Standard Registration** items noted above **plus** APA Annual Meeting on Demand (see below). A \$10 U.S. shipping fee or \$45 international shipping fee is added.

<u>APA Annual Meeting on Demand</u> is a digital library of over 300 hours of educational content presented at the Annual Meeting. If you sign up for Gold Registration, you will have access to APA Annual Meeting on Demand both online and on a USB drive. Sessions will be available online within 24 hours of the live presentation. Instructions on how to access the online content will be sent to you on May 21 via email from <u>orders@CMEonCall.com</u>. If you do not receive the email, please check your junk mail or contact <u>support@CMEonCall.com</u>. The USB drive will be automatically sent to you approximately eight weeks after the meeting.

## **ON-SITE CHECK IN AND REGISTRATION**

When you arrive for the meeting, you should go to the San Diego Convention Center to check in and pick up your meeting materials. Onsite you will receive your meeting badge, *Guide to the 2017 Annual Meeting, APA Committee and Allied Group Meetings Book*, lanyard and a tote bag. The *Syllabus* will be available for viewing or download on the Annual Meeting website <a href="www.psychiatry.org/annualmeeting">www.psychiatry.org/annualmeeting</a>. The *Guide to the 2017 Annual Meeting* includes session details and locations and the *Exhibits Guide*. Your meeting badge will include any course tickets you purchased. If you have an early morning course, we suggest that you check in and pick up your materials the day before.

#### **SCIENTIFIC SESSIONS**

All scientific sessions (except posters) offer CME credit. Courses are in-depth half or full day sessions that require an additional fee. You must register for the meeting first to be able to purchase course tickets. You can enroll in courses when you register for the meeting. Courses can be added after registering for the meeting by visiting the attendee service center.

To be admitted into your course, you must present your course ticket. To attend a session that is not a course, use the *Guide to the 2017 Annual Meeting* distributed on site to find the session room. You should arrive at least 20 minutes before the session since seating is on a first-come, first-served basis. No separate registration is required, but your registration badge is required for entry and will be checked at the door.

## **CONTINUING EDUCATION**

Participants will be given the opportunity to evaluate and provide feedback of their learning experience, enter the total credits they are claiming and obtain a CME certificate. To document credits, attendees should maintain a list of sessions they attend on the CME Daily Attendance Log located in the *Guide to the 2017 Annual Meeting* or via APA's Meetings app. Credit is earned on an hour-for-hour basis. <u>All scientific sessions are designated for *AMA PRA Category 1 Credits*, except for poster sessions.</u>

To obtain CME Certificate for physicians or a Certificate of Attendance for non-physicians stop by the CME Certificate Booth located at the San Diego Convention Center, Ballroom 20 Foyer Upper Level, or access the evaluation online at <a href="http://www.psychiatry.org/AnnualMeetingCME">http://www.psychiatry.org/AnnualMeetingCME</a> during or after the meeting until August 2017.

CME credit for APA members completing the evaluation will be recorded at <u>education.psychiatry.org</u> and transferred to the ABPN Physician Folio in August. The American Psychiatric Association (APA) is accredited by the ACCME to provide continuing medical education for physicians. APA designates this live activity for a maximum of 40 *AMA PRA Category 1*  $Credits^{m}$ . Physicians should claim only the credit commensurate with the extent of their participation in the activity.

## **MEALS**

Formal meals are not included in your registration fee; however, some of the sponsored Therapeutic Updates and Product Theaters provide meals. The *Guide to the 2017 Annual Meeting* will list these activities, as well as how these are recorded per the Physician Payment Sunshine Act. Free coffee and refreshments are provided in the APA Cafés in the Exhibit Hall.
