

Niemann-Pick disease type C (NPC) is a rare genetic disorder that can affect individuals at any age, presenting with unusual combinations of common symptoms<sup>1,2</sup>

People with NPC may be hard to diagnose because the individual symptoms overlap with other common diseases. By recognizing certain combinations, NPC may be diagnosed earlier.<sup>3</sup>
