AMBASSADORS-PEOPLE YOU CAN TRUST

Our ambassadors are here to help!

1. Staffed by retired police officers, the **SFPD Community Ambassador** program places over 30+ ambassadors, 11am-9pm daily, in the downtown area and other tourist neighborhoods with deployment expanded to the Moscone area during APA.
2. [SF Welcome Ambassadors](#) are mobile concierges, operating 8am to 8pm daily with 92 employees.
3. [The Union Square Alliance](#): 24/7 service, cleaning to walking escorts (allow 30 min., coverage area Moscone Center to Union Square). 415-781-4456
4. [The Yerba Buena Community Benefit District](#) guides surround Moscone Center offering a Clean Team, Community Guides, and walking escorts (6:30am-9:30pm, allow 30 min. for response). 415-543-9223
5. [Urban Alchemy Ambassadors](#) are throughout Mid-Market and the Tenderloin for 10-12 hours a day supporting the community.
